The Randolph County Board of Education met in special session on Thursday, April 7, 2005, at 5:30 p.m., in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room. LaVerne Williams, Becky Coltrane, Grady Lawson, Tommy McDonald, Paul Guthrie, Gary Cook and Janet Johnson were present for the meeting.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order.

Announcement of Superintendency

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that Donald E. Andrews be offered a four-year contract as Superintendent of the Randolph County Schools beginning July 1, 2005. Paul Guthrie stated that he wished to abstain from voting due to illness that had prevented him from involvement in the interview and selection process. The motion carried: 6-0. Chair LaVerne Williams stated that Mr. Andrews was currently the superintendent of the Harnett County Schools and served as superintendent in both Camden and Graham Counties. He has been Assistant Superintendent for Personnel and Administrative Services. His experience includes being the principal of Walter William High School in the Alamance/Burlington School District and of Forbush High School in Yadkin County Schools. He is a graduate of Winthrop University with an Education Specialist Degree and a Masters Degree in Educational Administration. He received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Mr. Andrew is married and has two children.

Mr. Andrews stated it was an honor and privilege to be selected as Superintendent of Randolph County Schools. He gave special thanks to his wife and children for being willing to relocate.
