August 16, 2004

The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, August 16, 2004, at 6 p.m. in Board Room B at the Central Office.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: P. Guthrie, A. Lanier, T. McDonald, G. Lawson, B. Scott, and B. Coltrane.

Moment of Silence

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson LaVerne Williams led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognition of Guests

Chairperson Williams recognized principal representatives Dana Albright-Johnson and Beverly Wilson. Archdale-Trinity Middle School Principal Dustin Johnson was also present for the meeting. Mrs. Williams also welcomed members of the press and guests in attendance.

Special Recognition

Assistant Superintendent Pat Foust introduced Seagrove School Teacher Mary Robinson who was named as Wal-Mart Art Teacher of the Year in this district. Mrs. Robinson will compete for the National Wal-Mart Teacher of the Year. She also designed the artwork for the North Carolina state quarter.

Minutes

T. McDonald made a motion seconded B. Coltrane that minutes of the meeting held on July 19, 2004, be approved as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Adoption of Agenda

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the Board adopt the agenda as presented with the addition of an discussion item regarding NCSBA Awards and the deletion of a close session scheduled for discussion of a legal matter. The motion carried: 7-0.

Consent Items

G. Lawson made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie that the Board approve consent items as presented:

1. Assignments and Releases – 99 assignments, 22 releases, and 9 denials for the 2004-2005 school year.
2. Second Reading of Policy – 7505 Duty Free Period.

The motion carried: 7-0.

New Calendar Legislation

T. McDonald made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the system begin school no earlier than August 25, 2005, for the 2005-2006 school year and that the Calendar Committee that designed the 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 school calendars redesign the 2005-2006 calendar to reflect this action and present a revised calendar for Board approval no later than the October 18 meeting of the Board of Education. The motion carried: 7-0. Superintendent McRae reported that there were some parts of the school calendar legislation that required clarification needed before the new calendar could be designed. A new calendar committee will be organized to design the 2006-2007 calendar, which will be presented to the Board in the spring of 2006.

Opening of School Update

Superintendent McRae reported that he was extremely pleased with the preparations made for the beginning of school. He visited all schools during the first week of school and found them to be organized and back to the business of education as if they had only been away for a weekend. He commended custodial staffs for their hard work over the summer months in making school facilities look better than ever. Dr. Russ Gobble, Executive Director of Auxiliary Services, reported 18,249 students had enrolled in school by the fifth day of the 2004-2005 school year. This is 24 more students than projected and 289 more students than on the fifth day of the previous school year. Most of the growth is in the already overcrowded high schools. Dr. McRae reported that personnel allotments would be adjusted accordingly.

NCSBA Award

Dr. McRae reported that the Asheboro City Board of Education had invited the Randolph County Board of Education to join them in nominating the Randolph County Board of County Commissioners for a North Carolina School Boards Association award because of their support for education. The Board of Commissioners has supported the Randolph County Schools in continued funding as well as funding construction of facilities and increasing supplements over the past several years. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the Randolph County Board of Education join the Asheboro City Board of Education in nominating the Randolph County Board of Commissioners for the NCSBA Award.
