Testing Update

Vicki Moss, Director of Testing and Accountability, presented unofficial ABC information for the 2006-2007 school year.

No Child Left Behind School Choice Update

Cathy Brady, Director of Elementary Education, presented a proposed plan for schools of choice for 2007-2008. She reported that Southmont Elementary may possibly be in Year 2 of School Improvement and students may choose to attend Farmer or Seagrove Elementary Schools. If Farmer or Seagrove does not meet their AYP targets, then Southmont students may choose to attend Tabernacle. Ramseur School may be in their first year of School Improvement. If that is the case, Ramseur students may choose to attend Coleridge or Franklinville Elementary Schools. If Coleridge or Franklinville do not meet AYP targets, Grays Chapel and Liberty Elementary Schools would be an option. Mrs. Brady reminded the Board that only schools that receive Title I funds are subject to federal sanctions such as public school choice. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the plan be approved as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

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Extracurricular and non-Instructional Duties

Superintendent Andrews made a recommendation that effective July 1, 2008, all physical education teachers at middle and high schools direct and/or assist a minimum of two sports each academic year unless otherwise waived by the principal. G. Cook made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the Board approved the recommendation of the superintendent as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Athletics Sportsmanship/Ejection Policy

Superintendent Donald Andrews recommended that the Board approve a policy on athletic sportsmanship. The policy gives examples of behavior or conduct which would result in ejection from an athletic contest and how individual and total ejections will affect a team in terms of disqualification from participation in playoffs. G. Lawson made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that the policy be approved as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Budget Update

Dare Campbell, Assistant Finance Officer, reported that the current expense budget request was for \$17,315,941 and the school system received \$15,906,298 (2.76% increase over last year). With this funding, a projected increase in Low Wealth funding and DSSF funding, the following items will be included in the 2007-2008 budget: A supplement increase (1% for teachers and principals, 2% directors and supervisors); five lead teachers at a cost of \$175,000, increase in internet bandwidth at a cost of \$400,000, and two additional roofers at an approximate cost of \$60,000. Capital Outlay budget items will be funded using approximately \$150,000 from State funds and appropriated capital fund balance.

Facility Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Director of Facilities and Construction, shared pictures of construction at Providence Grove High School. He reported that the construction is within the timeline.

Mr. Trotter reported that 14 mobile units had been ordered for the coming school year.

He also reported that bids for Wheatmore School will be received on Thursday, July 19, at 3 p.m. in Board Room B. A contract for construction will be awarded at the July 24 meeting of the board.

Central Office Space

Superintendent Andrews reported that Cooperative Extension was moving out of the complex and part of their office space would be assigned to the school system. He also reported that the administrative building was rearranging some office space to facilitate work flow due to reassigned duties.
