The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, July 16, 2012 at 6 p.m. in the Central Office Board Room.

Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Public Comments

Ms. Savannah Tinnin with Ramseur Athletic Association spoke to the Board regarding the proposal of the use of facilities hourly fees/rates. She asked the board to keep in mind to be lenient with rates due to each organization taking care of their own students. She also expressed many continue to help that do not have children of their own involved and do not pay themselves a fee.

Instruction

Continuous Improvement Performance Plan (CIPP)

Carol VonCannon – Distributed and reviewed snapshot reference of 20 indicators. Ms. VonCannon stated each LEA has 20 indicators. There is a plan in place to address those not met. A plan has been sent to the Department of Public Instruction.

Administration

School Calendar (2013-2014)

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, discussed information regarding the school calendar legislation. He stated the process will be to bring back information on the 2013-2014 calendar at the August work session with a proposed calendar presented in October and then approved in November.

Policy 5030 Community Use of Facilities

Mr. Trotter gave an update regarding previous information presented on charges for use of facilities. The recommendation presented was to leave the policy as is for groups to not be charged if they contribute back to the schools. Outside groups that do not make a contribution back to the schools the fees would remain the same.

2012-2013 Budget

Todd Lowe, Finance Officer, presented the 2012-2013 Budget. After review and discussion, E. Coltrane made a motion seconded by B. Coltrane to approve the 2012-2013 Budget as presented. Motion carried: 7-0. The Resolution as approved by the Board is as follows:
