

Regular Session
June 16, 2008

The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, June 16, 2008, at 4 p.m. in the Central Office Board Room.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: B. Coltrane, G. Cook, P. Guthrie, J. Johnson, G. Lawson, and T. McDonald.

Moment of Silence

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance

Seceley Honeycutt and Mason Campbell, 5th graders at Franklinville Elementary, led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognition of Guests

Chairperson Williams recognized principal representative, Jeff Uhlenberg. Larry Chappell, Assistant Principal at A-T Middle was also present.

Minutes

Adoption of Agenda

Testing and Accountability

Director, Dr. Sharon Johnson, stated that final information will be presented at a later date. She wants the information to be as clean and accurate as possible. Final date to DPI will be June 30, 2008. Dr. Johnson stated that reports will be presented to Mr. Andrews and Ms. Pat Foust in July.

Spanish Immersion Program – Hopewell Elementary

Sharon Harper, Principal of Hopewell Elementary, reported that the Spanish Emersion Program had an outstanding first year. 2007-2008 Assessment results were presented. Ms. Harper reported that 39 of the 103 students that are registered for Kindergarten for the 2008-2009 school year requested Spanish immersion placement. Ms. Harper also presented options for the program for the 2008-2009 school year.

Wheatmore High School Curriculum

Kim Johnson, Director of High Schools and Ann Callicutt, Director of Career-Technical Education brought to the Board in June a recommendation from the Wheatmore Task Force to approve the Residential Plus Duplication Program. The Board was to give their final decision at the June 16, 2008 meeting. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by J. Johnson to approve the Residential Plus Duplication Program for Wheatmore High School. The motion carried: 6-0

Summer Board Retreat

Superintendent Andrews reported that the Summer Board Retreat was scheduled for Tuesday, August 19, 2008. Mr. Andrews asked the Board to notify him of any areas or issues the Board would like to discuss at the retreat.

Facility Construction Update for Providence Grove High School and Wheatmore High School

Providence Grove High School - Katherine Peele, with LS3P Associates Ltd., reported that a temporary certificate of occupancy from the inspector should be given by Monday, June 23, 2008. This would allow furniture, fixtures, and athletic equipment to be moved in, but one cannot permanently occupy the building.

Wheatmore High School - Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations reported that steel continues to go up, metal decking installed in some areas, concrete floors scheduled to be poured in the gym areas, and the gravel is down on the student parking lot. The construction crew is moving ahead and trying to make up time by working extra hours and supplementing with additional subs.

District Lines

Mr. Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, provided maps for review. The map utilizes both Braxton Craven School and A-T Middle School as 6-8 grade configurations. Mobile units would have to be used at the Braxton Craven campus. Braxton Craven athletic programs would have to share with Trinity High School athletic facilities.

High School Gym HVAC Projects

Mr. Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations recommended to the Board for their approval the low bid of \$1,553,500 from H.M. Kern. The engineer would have a preconstruction meeting and construction would begin immediately. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie to approve the gym HVAC project with H.M. Kern Construction in Greensboro for \$1,553,500. The motion carried: 6-0.

Closed Session

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Cook that the Board go into closed session to discuss the terms of an employment contract as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(5). The

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motion carried: 6-0.

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by T. McDonald to return to open session. The motion carried: 6-0.

P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by G. Cook that the Board approve the recommendations of Superintendent Donald Andrews to name Ms. Yvonne Gilmer, Principal of Grays Chapel Elementary and Mr. Brandon Scruggs, Principal of Eastern Randolph High School. Motion carried: 6-0.

Administrative Contract

J. Johnson made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie to extend the Administrative Contract of Ms. Pat Foust, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, to June 30, 2011 to make the contract a full three years. Motion carried: 6-0.
