The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, June 20, 2005, at 5 p.m. in Board Room B at the Central Office.

Call to Order

Preliminary Test Results

Director of Accountability Vicki Moss presented preliminary test results for the 2004-2005 school year. She reported writing scores had decreased in grade 7, reading scores had increased in every grade but sixth, and math scores had decreased slightly in almost every grade. Preliminary ABC results show increases in high school Algebra I, English I, Biology, and Physical Science, while scores were about the same for Geometry, Algebra II, and Physics. Chemistry scores had decreased slightly.

The Board set August 16 from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. for the summer work session. Some topics will include the superintendent transition, student test data, and construction issues.

Personnel Report

Superintendent McRae asked that the Board include in personnel action a one-year contract with Educator's Solutions LLC for services with Wanda Lucas and a four-year contract for superintendent with Donald E.
