Administration

Wheatmore High School Vocational Program Request

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, and Mr. Kevin Curry, Teacher at Wheatmore High School spoke to the Board of a grant opportunity from Doak Finch and Farm Bureau. Mr. Curry and school administration felt a small facility to teach management practices of animal operations would be the best way to utilize the dollars. The building plans, location of facility, goals, and budget were presented to the Board for review and questions. The Board had specific questions and comments such as the placement of the facility interfering with any future expansion on the property, funding for continuation of the program, and the project being presented to the A-T Tax Council. Mr. Trotter stated the facility would not interfere with future expansions and a presentation had not been presented to A-T Tax Council due to receiving the Board's approval on the project before moving forward. Mr. Curry stated the plan presented everything needed for the different stages and he felt confident in receiving more grant support. Board members also spoke of the positives as related to other high schools in our system with these facilities and programs. T. Boyles made a motion seconded by G. Instruction

2012-2013 Career and Technical Education Audit Report

Ms. Elizabeth Standafer, Administrator for Career and Technical Education presented a summary of the audit report from the Department of Public Instruction. Ms. Standafer also reviewed the areas of non-compliance and will be reviewing these areas further for some renovations.
