Report on School Opening

Dr. Russ Gobble, Assistant Superintendent of Auxiliary Services, reported that administrators and teachers had done a great job in an excellent school opening. He reported that the 10-day membership for the system was 18,849 students. He expressed appreciation to bus coordinators and routing specialists for their work in preparing for transportation of students.

SAT Update

Vicki Moss, Director of Testing and Accountability, presented comparative SAT results for the 2004-2006 classes. Writing was added to the SAT for the class of 2006. Randolph County Schools tested 48.2 percent of students. The total score is below the state and national average.

Selection of Brick for Providence Grove High School

Members of the Board looked at brick and roof samples for Providence Grove High School. G. Lawson made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that red brick and a medium green roof be approved for the school. The motion carried: 7-0. The Superintendent reported that he would also ask the architect to look into a way to eliminate glare in the media center due to the design of windows in that section of the building.
