CML and Wordmasters

Quizlet helping students prepare

The Continental Math League (CML) and Wordmasters competition preparation is in full swing in grades 3 through 7. CML meets occur the first week of every month from November until March. There are three meets for the Wordmaster's Challenge, one having been last week, the next happening during the first two weeks of February, and the final meet taking place during the first few weeks in April. Cumulative Champions will be announced in mid-May. In order to succeed on these challenges, students must

work extremely hard to expand their vocabulary, understand the words in context, and connect word meanings to difficult associations through analogies. In order to do this, some teachers have been using Quizlet to practice vocabulary across the curriculum. Quizlet is an online tool that is linked to student Google accounts that employs fun games to play and visual representations with vocabulary to help students practice word associations.
