- What does the future of farming look like in Rappahannock County?
- Do sports and music matter in school?
- How does internet access affect the lives of people in Rappahannock, including you?
- What are the factors or issues that influence voters in Rappahannock County?

Submission: Essays must be emailed to hjenkins@rappahannockschools.us by November 25th. You will receive a response once the essay has been received. **Please include your grade level in the subject line.**

Judging & Prizes: The essays will be judged in two separate grade categories (Elementary School/6th-7th grades and High School/8th-12th grades). A judging panel will select a 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place winner for grades 6th-7th. For grades 8th-12th, we will select one (1) 1st place winner, two (2) 2nd place winners, and two (2) 3rd place winners due to the larger number of potential entries. 1st place winners will each receive \$100 cash prize. 2nd place winners will each receive \$50 cash prize. 3rd place winners will each receive \$25 cash prize. In addition, winning essays will be published in the Rappahannock News. Previous winners may enter. Judges will not see student names when judging.
