

## *Red Oak FFA Alumni Chapter Senior Scholarship Information/Requirements*

The Red Oak FFA Alumni Chapter are accepting applications from Senior FFA members for the annual Senior Scholarship Awards. The Red Oak FFA Alumni Chapter has established funds for a limited number of non-renewable scholarships to be awarded to qualifying senior FFA members. Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis for those students with the highest scores on the application response and based on the eligibility requirements listed below.

### Eligibility Requirements

1. The student or student's family MUST be an active member of the Red Oak FFA Alumni Chapter.
2. The applicant must be a senior who is presently a member of FFA.
3. The student must be an active, contributing member of FFA, participating in not only daily classes, but also the responsibilities to your project and any competitions for the past 3 years.
4. Parent(s) must have been active in booster meetings and events by attending at least 50% of the meetings and volunteering at least one event per year for the past 3 years.
5. The student must have met all academic accomplishments through his/her first 3 ½ years of high school.
6. A letter of acceptance or a copy of the signature page of the student's application for college admission should accompany this application. If these are not available, attach pertinent documentation that you feel demonstrates your intent to attend a college, university, trade school, or other accredited program.

**Applications must be turned in to Mr. Mullican or Mr. Robinson by 12 noon on Monday, May 1, 2017**

Scholarship recipients will be named at the FFA Banquet in May 2017 and at the Senior Scholarships Awards Night. The recipients will receive a certificate for the amount of scholarship awarded. The monetary awards will only be released from the FFA Alumni Chapter upon demonstration of the student's fulfillment of all the requirements noted above.

### Payment of Scholarship

The payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the college, university, trade school or other accredited program. No payment will be made to the scholarship recipient or recipient's family member. The scholarship must be paid out by the spring semester of the year following the student's high school graduation.

The scholarship recipient must provide the ROHS FFA Alumni Chapter with the school name and mailing address for scholarships, their student ID number at the school they will be attending, and a copy of their completed registration form for the term they will be attending after graduation (summer, fall, or spring) or a class schedule for the term they will be attending.
