

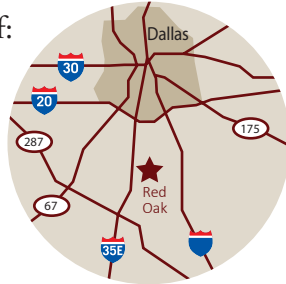
Red Oak ISD Fingertip FACTS
