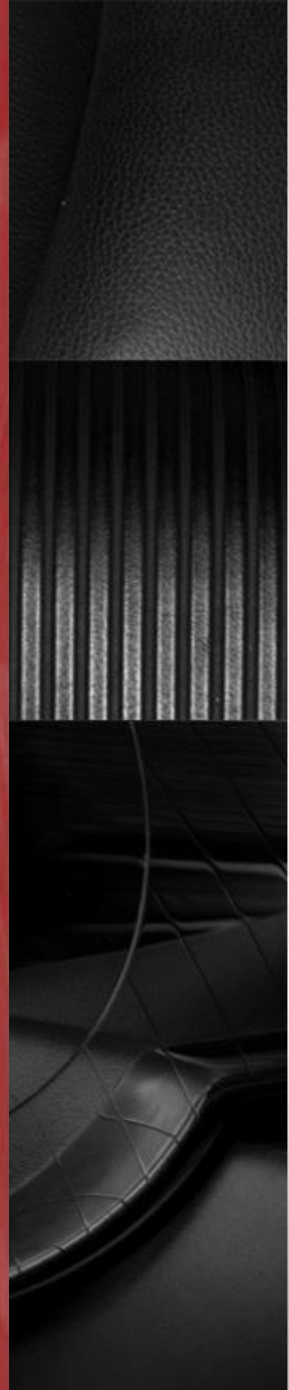

Parents may go online and view their student's test scores at any time.

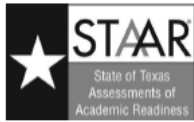
■ They need three pieces of information:

- The link for the website
- Their child's date of birth
- The *Unique Access Code* for their child



Where do they find the Unique Access Code?

- After the child takes their first state test they are assigned a Unique Access Code which remains the same through graduation. It is located on the Confidential Student Report that is sent home after each test. **The location is on the next slide.**

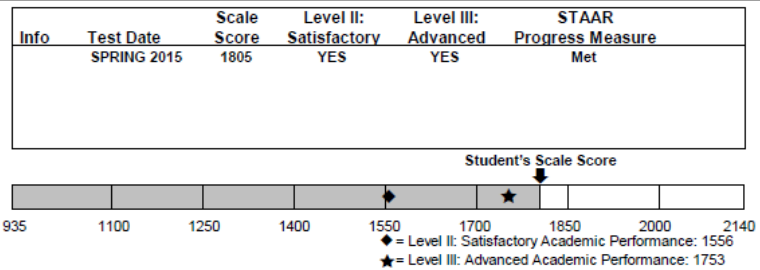

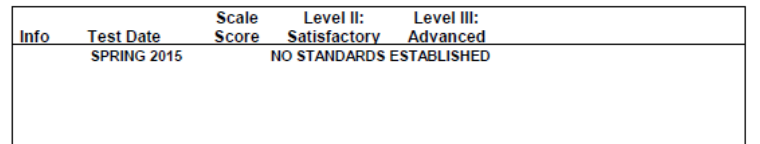

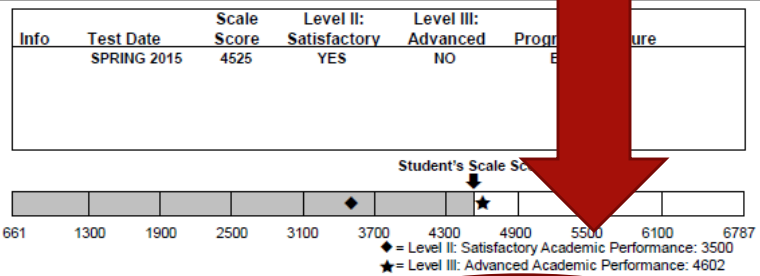

To log in and view your assessment results, enter your six-character Unique Access Code and the student's date of birth that appears on your most recent Confidential Student Report.

The Unique Access Code will contain a combination of numbers and capital letters. The access code is case sensitive and must be entered exactly as it appears on the most recent Confidential Student Report.

One important thing to remember:

- **TEA posts the parent portal information before the schools receive the official reports. There will be a period of time when the parent knows the student score before the school does. Keep this in mind if you need to contact the school with questions.**
