## Hispanic Scholarships:

**Hispanic Scholarship Fund (HSF)** – National: Deadline is March 30. Opens January 1 and allows students to apply for multiple scholarships with one application! Minimum GPA of 3.0. Go online and create your own MyHSF profile.

**Hispanic Annual Salute** – National: Deadline is April 28. Minimum GPA of 2.5. Demonstrate unpaid community service.

Random Scholarships: Google it for more info and applications!

**Southeast Power –** Local: Deadline is February 5. Must receive power to your home from them.

CrossLites Scholarship – National: Deadline is December 31. Write a reflective essay of 400-600 words.

AXA Achievement – National: Deadline is December 15.

**Bigger Picture Purpose Contest** – National: Deadline is December 31.

State of the American Mind Essay or Video Contest – National: Deadline is December 31.

Walmart Foundation Award – National: Deadline is January 14.

First Generation Grants (many available and college specific)

Colorado Council on High School Relations – National: Deadline is January 29. 2.5 GPA and volunteerism.
