### **Chromebook Protection Program 2019-2020 Grades 7-12**

Students in grades 7 - 12 receive a Chromebook to use throughout the school year. Students and their parent(s) and/or guardian(s) are required to review and sign the district's Acceptable Use Policy and District Device Agreement. Students who have not already signed both documents will receive them at school. Beginning with the classes of 2022 and 2023, seniors are permitted to keep their devices upon graduation and are required to purchase a district-approved Chromebook case and enroll in the Chromebook Protection Program (device insurance). It is strongly recommended that all students in grades 7-12 participate in the Chromebook Protection Program.

**Cost:** \$25 - **Chromebook insurance for all students** for the 2019-2020 School Year, non-refundable  
\$25 – **Chromebook Carrying Case**, one-time cost for grade 9 and new incoming transfer students in grade 10. *(Total cost for grade 9 and new grade 10 transfers is \$50 for 2019-2020.)*

**Payments:** Checks may be made payable to **Rocky Hill Public Schools** and handed in to the main office at your child's school **or** you may pay online at [www.mypaymentsplus.com](http://www.mypaymentsplus.com). *(Choose the \$50 "Grade 9/New Transfer Grade 10 fee for students in grade 9 and new grade 10 transfers.)*

**Deadlines:** Payments are due by **November 1, 2019**. Please call your school principal if you require financial assistance. If payment is not received by November 1, 2019, student accounts will be indebted for the cost of the program.

#### **Coverage included in the Protection Program:**

- ✓ Accidental Damage, including replacement. *If damage is intentional, the student and their parent(s) and/or guardian(s) will be responsible to pay for damages.*
- ✓ Theft, Robbery, Burglary *(requires a filed police report within 24 hours of incident)*
- ✓ Cracked Screens, Collisions, Drops, Falls & Missing keys
- ✓ Liquid Spills & Submersion
- ✓ Power surges
- ✓ Flood & Fire *(requires police report)*
- ✓ Vandalism not by student *(requires a filed police report within 24 hours of incident)*
- ✓ Receive an immediate replacement if Chromebook requires repair work included in coverage
- ✓ Manufacturer Warranty Coverage & Support

**Not included:** lost Chromebooks, lost or damaged power adapters and cases.

**Other important information:** If a student withdraws from Rocky Hill Public Schools and re-enrolls later in the same year, the protection purchased at the initial registration will be re-instated. If a student has not yet paid for Chromebook insurance, payment will be required at the time of repair. If payment is not made, program benefits are not extended to the student, including replacement devices. For students not enrolled in the program, limited loaners are available at the library media center and must be returned at the end of each day.
