

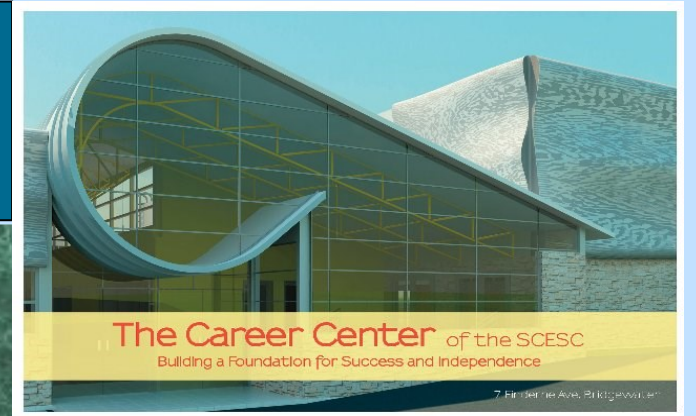

Career Center Enrollment Information

- Our program is open to Special Education students who are non-aggressive.
- Minimum 3rd grade reading level preferred.
- Full day program runs from 8:30 AM – 2:07 PM.
Includes all academic content areas and shop classes.
- Part day program runs from 12:46 PM – 2:07 PM.
Includes shop portion only.

Career Center Program Descriptions

- The Career Center has the academic and vocational capabilities of serving a wide range of students with mild to severe educational disabilities.
- The Career Center houses a ShopRite convenience size store for students enrolled in the Supermarket Careers program.
 - The Power Equipment Technology learning lab is for students on the power tools and small engine repair track.
 - Graphic Arts & Design will provide skills and experiences to students in order to prepare them for work in various fields of computer technology and graphics.



Somerset Elementary Academy

Special Education (grades K-8):

This program meets all IEP (Individualized Education Program) requirements for classified elementary and middle school students (ages 5-12) including all appropriate level instruction, special events, and the BEP (Behavioral Evaluation Plan).

Special Education (grades 9-12):

This program meets IEP (Individualized Education Program) requirements for classified students (ages 13 to 21) with emphasis on academic achievement and behavioral improvement.

Educational programming also includes the School-to-Work program, with students receiving hourly wages. This assists the student's transition into the workplace.

Alternative Academic Programs (grades 5-8):

This program offers students an alternative setting to the traditional classroom. Students receive increased attention from certified teachers in small group environments. The main goal of the Middle School Program is to help students reconnect with the learning experience and reintegrate them back into their sending school districts. Students are also monitored via a BEP.

Alternative Academic Programs (grades 9-12):

This program assists students in realizing their academic and social potential by participating in a proficiency-based program that allows them to work at an individualized pace. Students earn high school credits through this innovative program, ultimately leading to high school graduation. Our full-time social worker assists students in finding appropriate post-secondary placement.
