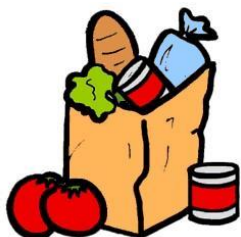
SVDP MEETING: The next meeting will be held Thursday, January 23, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. All are welcome to join us.
