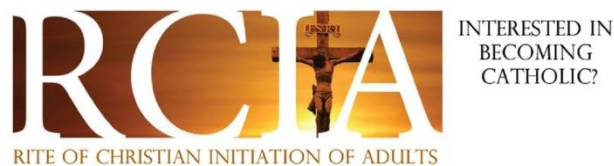
FAITH FORMATION Faith Formation has concluded. Have a great summer and we look forward to seeing you at VBS!
