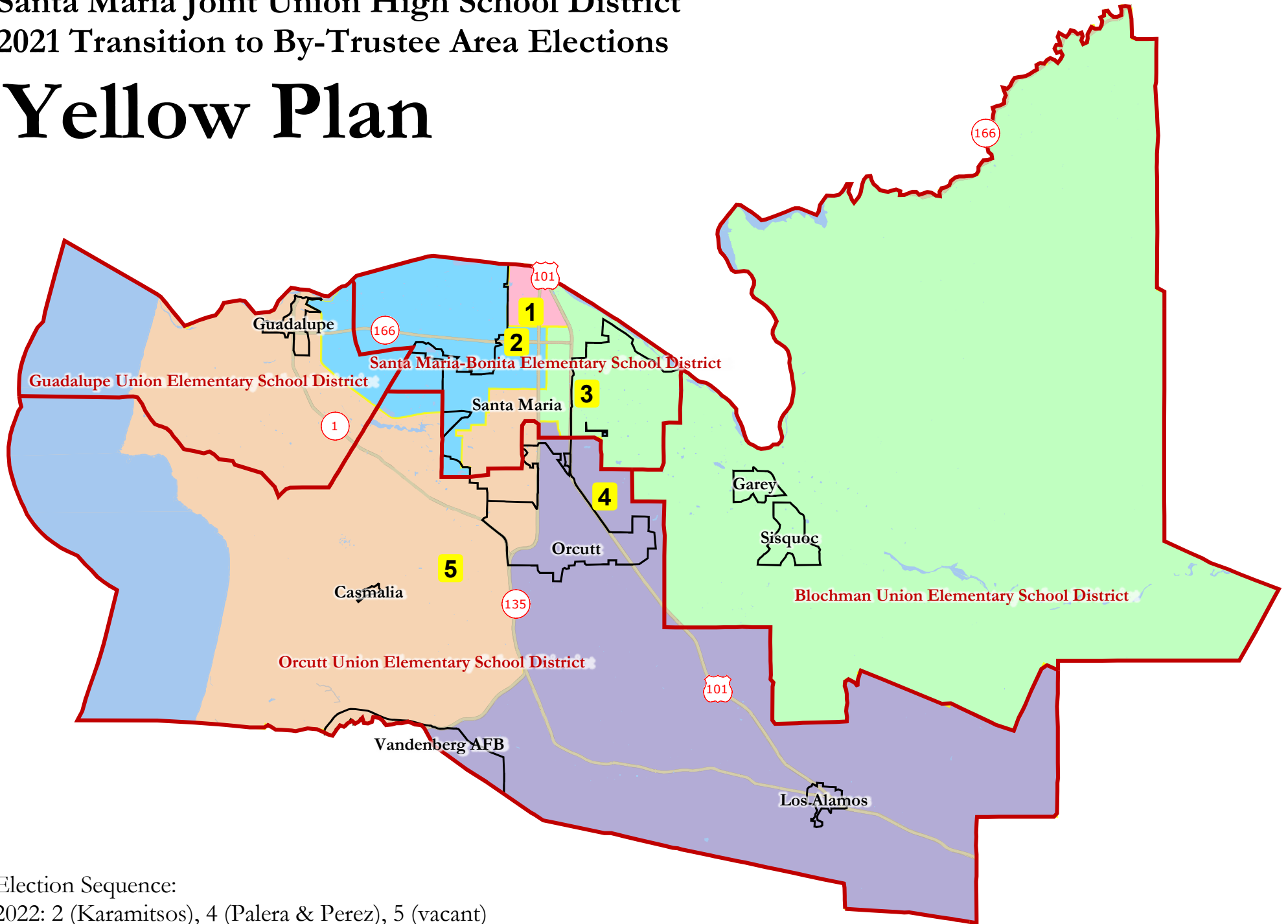


Santa Maria Joint Union High School District 2021 Transition to By-Trustee Area Elections
