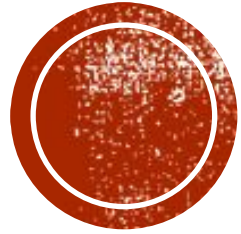

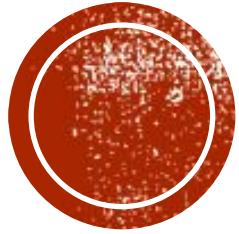

PERSONAL GRADUATION PLAN

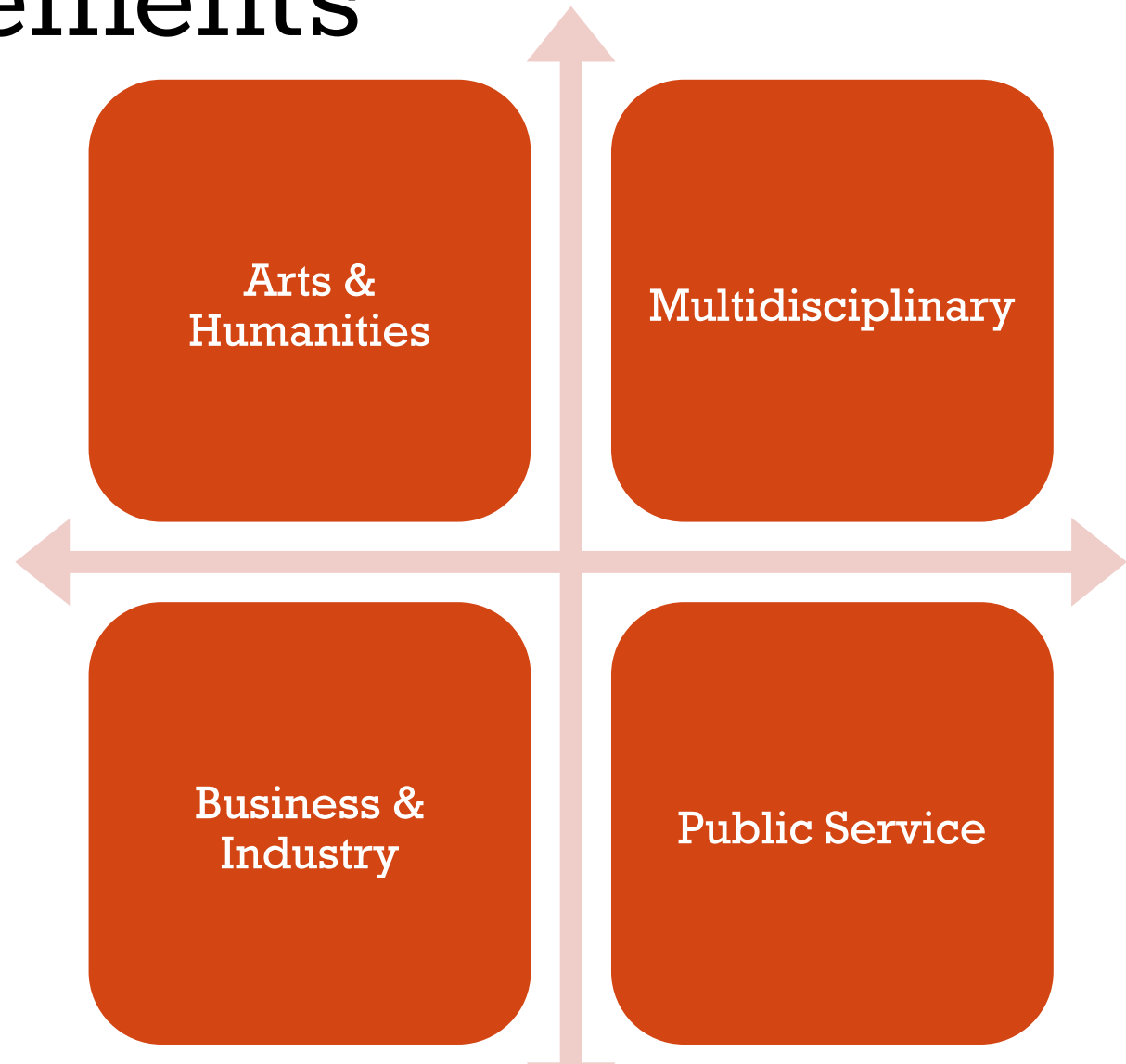
