On July 18, 2016, the Shelby Public Schools Board of Education approved the following changes to our student athletic pay-to-participate fee plan for the 2016-2017 school year for school sponsored athletics for students in grades 6-12.

- The fee per middle school student will be a flat rate of \$40 for one or more sports.
- The fee for high school student will be a flat rate of \$75 for one or more sports.
- A family will not be charged more than \$200 in total fees.

Payment **must be received** by the Shelby High School office prior to the **first practice of the season**. Please contact the High School office for payment options at (231) 861-4811.

This fee partially covers the cost of the items listed below. Other school district funds cover the remaining amount.

Athletics:

- Equipment & Uniforms
- Transportation to Events
- Officials, Game Management, and Supervision
- Tournament Fees
- Awards

Payment is **NON REFUNDABLE** if a student becomes ineligible or chooses to drop out of a sport after the first contest of the season.

Insurance: Shelby Public Schools will no longer offer insurance for sports related injuries, and it will be the parent's responsibility to provide health insurance for their student athlete.
