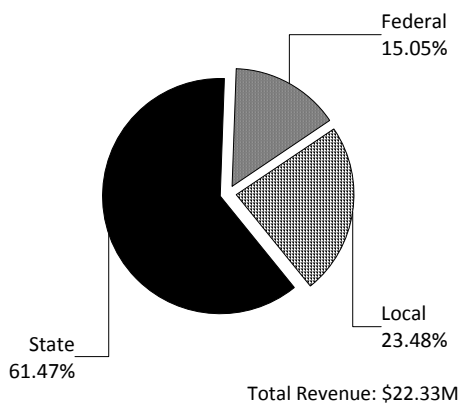

Revenue Sources



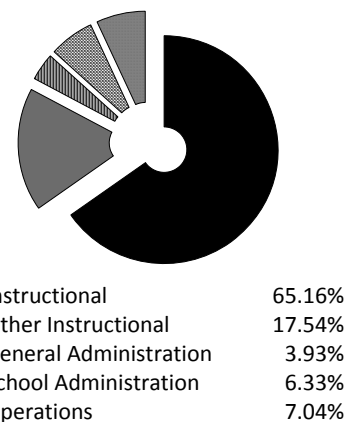
