# Welcome to Southampton Township Schools



Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the following enrollment information.

## Determine which school your child will attend:

If you have a child who is entering kindergarten through second grade, he or she will attend School #1. Any child enrolling for third through fifth grade will attend School #2. Middle school students (grades 6 – 8) will attend Southampton Township School #3. The telephone number and main office extension for each school are listed on the reverse side of the brochure.

## Register as early as possible:

All new students must complete the registration process prior to attending school. Registration and screening for kindergarten are scheduled for the spring and listed in the Southampton Township School Calendar and on our website [www.Southampton.k12.nj.us](http://www.Southampton.k12.nj.us). This information is also posted on the Lenape Regional School District Television Channel 18. New residents may enroll their children at any time during the year. Registering as early as possible will provide ample time to plan the appropriate placement of your child.

## Visit the school before your child begins attending:

Parents are encouraged to schedule an appointment to visit the school with their child before the child begins attending classes. The appropriate school principal will welcome the opportunity to take you and your child on a tour of the building and answer any questions you may have about the educational program.

## Developing an educational partnership between parents and the Southampton Township Schools:

The Board of Education, administration, teaching staff and PTA are dedicated to forging a strong partnership with parents, so that a quality education is provided to each student. Therefore, we encourage parents to familiarize themselves with the policies and programs provided by the school district. You may contact the main office of the school your child will be attending to request the annual state mandated school report card, brochures that describe school programs, the school calendar and other information.

## You will need to bring documents to complete the registration process:

Students can not be registered unless parents or guardians can prove that they live in the township, and that the student has met all of the entrance requirements for his or her grade.

## The following documents are required to register:

### For all students (kindergarten and transfer):

- **Immunization records.** These must include MMR immunizations: measles, mumps and rubella (German measles); and at least four DPT immunizations: diptheria, polio and tetanus for kindergarten enrollees.
- **Proof of Southampton Township residency.** Acceptable items include home deeds, new home agreements of sale and rental leases. A complete listing of acceptable proof of residency can be found on the school district's website:

### In addition for kindergarten students only:

- **Original birth certificate** as proof of age.
- **Recent physical examination** completed by your family physician using the form provided in the school district's registration packet.

### In addition for transfer students only:

- **Official state transfer card**, if your child is transferring from another school district in New Jersey.
