The Spotswood Board of Education, at its April 5th, Board meeting, swore in its newest member, William (Bill) Loschiavo. Bill replaces former Board member Jeff Cote who submitted his resignation on March 6th. A job promotion will require Jeff and his family to move to Massachusetts. The Board chose Bill for the vacant position from among three well qualified candidates.



Bill has been employed by L’Oreal USA in Clark for the past four years and is currently the Director of Contract Manufacturing. He holds a BS in Civil Engineering from Rutgers University. Originally from Staten Island, Bill and his wife Kimberly have made Spotswood their home for the past 10 years.
