

The Spotswood Board of Education at its meeting of April 21, 2009, accepted with regret the letter of resignation for the purpose of retirement from Superintendent of Schools Dr. John Krewer effective November 1, 2009.

Dr. Krewer, completing his 45th year in education on June 30, began service in Spotswood in January 2006. While in the district, he worked with staff in aligning the curriculum to meet all state standards while establishing a five year curriculum plan that reaches beyond those standards; increased Advanced Placement offerings at the high school to 12 classes; recruited outstanding teaching talent and established a three-year teacher training program to ensure their success and that of our learners. Additionally, he secured grants to enable the district to obtain educational programs at no cost.

“We would like to thank Dr. Krewer for his service to the Spotswood community, most especially its students,” said Rich O’Brien, President of the Spotswood Board of Education. “His academic expertise and contribution is immeasurable and it has been a privilege to work with him.” His letter of resignation is attached.
