



Mastroserio Appointed Middle School Principal

The Spotswood Board of Education at its meeting of December 2, 2008, appointed Michael Mastroserio as Principal of the Memorial Middle School effective January 1, 2009. Michael replaces Thomas Weaver who has served as middle school principal since 1994. Mr. Weaver, with 31 years of service, retires on December 31, 2008.

Mr. Mastroserio has been a member of the Spotswood administrative staff since October 2005, serving in the role of District Supervisor of Technology, Business and Vocational Education. Prior to coming to Spotswood, Mastroserio served as District Director/Supervisor of Social Studies in the Paterson Schools. At the building level, Michael served as Assistant Principal at Hammarskjold Middle School in East Brunswick, NJ and as a classroom teacher, he taught at the middle school level for seven years in the Lakewood Public Schools.

Mr. Mastroserio holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in History and Political Science from New York University and a Master of Arts in Educational Leadership from Georgian Court College. Michael is an active member of the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development and the International Society for Technology in Education.

Superintendent of Schools, Dr. John Krewer, describes Mr. Mastroserio as child-centered, passionate about learning, with an excellent grasp of middle level education and the needs of middle school students. Board President Richard O'Brien said, "Tom Weaver set the standard as the leader of the Memorial Middle School.
