 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE BOROUGH OF SPOTSWOOD IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A SPECIAL BALLOT QUESTION TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT VOTERS AT THE ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2015

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of the Borough of Spotswood in the County of Middlesex (the "Board" when referring to the governing body and the "School District" when referring to the territorial boundaries governed by the Board) desires to undertake a school facilities project in order to undertake improvements to various schools in the School District (the "Project");

WHEREAS, to accomplish the Project, the Board seeks to authorize the submission of a ballot question and an explanatory question at the annual School District election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2015 (the "Election") and to authorize certain actions required to be taken in connection with the conduct of the Election and the undertaking of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of Education of the Borough of Spotswood in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey (not less than a majority of the full membership of the Board concurring) as follows:

1. The following Explanatory Statement and Proposal (the "Proposal") shall be submitted to the legal voters of the School District at the annual School District election (the "Election") to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2015.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Board is seeking to undertake the following facilities improvements:

Safety and Security Improvements to all Schools

- High School: Installation of security cameras with video back up, installation of telecommunications system allowing for school wide communication
- Spotswood Memorial School: Installation of telecommunications system allowing for school wide communication
- G. Austin Schoenly School: Installation of security cameras with video back up, installation of telecommunications system allowing for school wide communications, upgraded fire alarm system
- Appleby Elementary School: Installation of security cameras with video back up, installation of telecommunications system allowing for school wide communications, upgraded fire alarm system

Energy Efficient HVAC Upgrades

- High School: AC upgrades to server room and locker room
- G. Austin Schoenly School: HVAC and control upgrades

Facility Upgrades/Improvements

- High School: Boys and girls locker room renovations, window replacement, track upgrades, bleacher and press box replacement, fencing, server upgrades,
- Appleby Elementary School: Playground surface improvements

Roof Replacement

- High School: Replacement of old roof with new, energy efficient roofing system
- Spotswood Memorial School: Replacement of old roof with new, energy efficient roofing system

TOTAL PROJECT COSTS

The total cost of the project shall not exceed \$9,343,707. The Board anticipates financing the project with bonds for approximately 20 years to fund the project. The Board has received an award of State funding in the amount of 33.7% of the total project costs which State funding reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 66.3%.

33.7% STATE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT

The Board has received State funding for the project in the form of debt service aid on the bonds issued for the Project. The State has awarded debt service aid in the amount of 34%.

This State aid reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 66% of the total project cost. Such State funding will only be available if the referendum passes.

PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Borough of Spotswood in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey is authorized to undertake a school facilities project consisting of (A) improvements to the High School including installation of security cameras and telecommunications system, boys' and girls' locker room renovations, window replacement, track upgrades, bleacher and press box replacement; fencing; server upgrades, roof replacement and HVAC upgrades to server room and locker room; (B) improvements to the Spotswood Memorial School including installation of telecommunications system and roof replacement; (C) improvements to G. Austin Schoenly School including installation of telecommunications system, installation of security cameras, upgraded fire alarm system and HVAC and control upgrades and (D) improvements to Appleby Elementary School including installation of telecommunications system, installation of security cameras, upgraded fire alarm system and playground surface improvements. The Board is authorized to expend on such project and issue bonds for such project in an amount not to exceed \$9,343,707. The State has agreed to provide debt service aid in the amount of 40% of the "final eligible costs" of the school facilities project (which equals 33.7% of the total project costs). \$7,893,644 of the costs of the project are "final eligible costs".

- 2. The Board hereby approves and adopts the Proposal and, subject to the approval of the legal voters of the School District, hereby determines to carry out the same.
- and directed, in conjunction with Bond Counsel, to deliver a certified copy of this resolution and such other information as shall be necessary to comply with applicable provisions of the Education Law and Election Law, to the Executive Middlesex County Superintendent of Schools, Middlesex County Clerk, Middlesex County Board of Elections, and to the Clerk of the Borough of Spotswood, and to request such persons to undertake their respective functions under the Education Law and the Election Law, as applicable, in connection with the Election. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary is hereby authorized to amend the Proposal and the Explanatory Statement to conform same to statutory requirements.
- 4. The Board hereby acknowledges and confirms that, in accordance with the requirements of Sections 24-16 and 24-17 of the Education Law, a Supplemental Debt Statement has been prepared as of the date of this resolution by the Chief Financial Officers of the Borough of Spotswood, giving effect to the proposed total authorization of School Bonds of the School District in the maximum amount provided for in the Proposal, and that such Supplemental Debt Statement has been filed in the offices of the Clerk of the Borough of Spotswood, and in the office of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary prior to the adoption of this resolution. The Board hereby directs the Business Administrator/Board Secretary to cause such Supplemental Debt Statement to be filed in the office of the Director

of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs prior to the date of the Election.

- 5. The School Administration and such other officers, professionals and agents of the Board as are necessary, including Wilentz, Goldman & Spitzer, P.A., Bond Counsel and the Architect for the Project, are each hereby authorized and directed to perform such acts, execute such documents and do such things as are necessary and proper for the submission of the Proposal to the voters of the School District at the Election, including preparation and submission of all required applications for receipt of debt service aid.
- 6. The Board hereby (i) accepts the determination of Preliminary Eligible Costs as set forth in the letters of the New Jersey Department of Education (the "NJDOE Eligibility Letters"); (ii) elects to receive the State Share in the form of debt service aid; (iii) determines to construct the Project; (iv) agrees to locally fund any excess costs and (v) delegates the supervision of the Project to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.
 - 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
