This includes processing and filing all required forms to apply to the NJ Department of Education- Office of School Facilities for processing of grant funding of the below referenced projects. The projects were previously approved by the NJ Department of Education for funding through the ROD Grant Program. The state share for each of the projects is 40% of the Total Estimated Project Costs. Further, Board approval is requested to award JDS Industrial the partial roofing replacement project at Spotswood High School and Memorial Middle School. JDS Industrial was the lowest responsible bid received with a total bid of \$1,847,000 with \$957,232 in grant funding coming from the State.
