Franciscan Corner

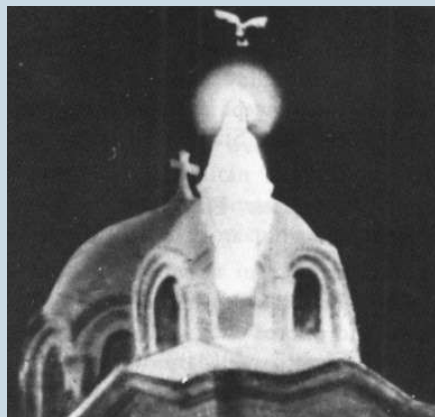
“This is my Body.” “Father forgive them.” “He is not here. He is going ahead of you....”

The Apparition at Zeitoun

In Zeitoun, on the outskirts of Cairo, a rich Copt who planned to build a house had a vision of the Virgin, who asked him to build a chapel there instead. She told him that she had passed that way with Joseph and Jesus at the time of the Flight into Egypt. In 1924, the man fulfilled her request and constructed a beautiful church with five domes. Much later, in 1968, workers employed at a mechanic’s shop across the street saw a woman dressed in white atop the main dome of the church. Thinking that she was someone about to commit suicide, perhaps a nun, the workers called out to her and summoned the police. The priest and other witnesses also saw her and understood that she was an apparition. The Virgin reappeared several times in the following days, to Muslims as well as to Christians. Sometimes she was accompanied by the child Jesus, sometimes by Joseph, or by both. Always silent, she remained visible for long moments, her appearances preceded by lightning flashes and flights of white birds. The apparitions continued several times each week for fourteen months, sometimes attracting fifty thousand witnesses. Healings occurred and photographs were even taken to document the phenomena. In 1969, the Coptic pope established the feast of the Transfiguration of the Virgin, celebrated at Zeitoun on the second of April.
