I am requesting Budget Amendment 2 be submitted for Board approval. I have listed below budget changes in this amendment. I have also attached a copy of the budget summary page after the proposed changes.

 - Added revenue and expenditures for additional Migrant allocation - \$17,812
 - Additional computers - \$70,000
 - Additional technology software - \$55,000
 - Added nurse expenditures - \$25,000
 - Added insurance proceeds for claims made and corresponding expenditures - \$72,000
 - Added expenditure for service van - \$35,000
 - Added increased costs in personnel for extra days – approximately \$30,000
 - Added revenue and related expenditures for A/P Grant- \$38,575
 - Added increase in sales tax revenue - \$230,000 and a decrease in ad-valorem - \$48,809.
