

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT this day made by and between **ST. CLAIR COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**, herein called "Board," and the **EAST COAST MIGRANT HEAD START PROJECT**, herein called "Agency".

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board owns certain real property located at 4484 Chandler Mountain Road, Steele, Alabama 35987, which property consists of approximately one (1) acre of land (the "Property") (A copy of the survey is attached hereto as Exhibit A); and,

WHEREAS, the Agency has leased the Property from the Board since at least June 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the Agency has requested and the Board has agreed to extend the lease of the Property to the Agency in accordance with the terms set forth in this Lease Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein expressed, the parties hereto agree and acknowledge as follows:

Now we need to go into executive session to discuss pending litigation for school session. Before going into executive session on these grounds, the Alabama Open Meetings Act requires an oral declaration reflected in the minutes from an attorney licensed to practice law in Alabama that this exception is applicable to the planned discussion, and I make that declaration. We need a motion calling for an executive session to discuss this matter and a roll call vote of each member of this Board needs to be recorded in the minutes. We are also required to give an estimated time that the executive session will take. After discussion it was decided that it would take approximately 20 to 30 minutes. The Board will reconvene at that time. Mrs. Manning ask for a motion to adjourn to executive session. Mrs. Cobb made a motion to dismiss to executive session and Mr. Thompson gave the second. Mrs. Manning, Mr. Thompson and Mr. Morris, Mrs. Cobb, Ms. Gray and Mr. DeGaris voted in favor of dismissing to executive session.

At 7:59 Mrs. Manning ask for a vote to reconvene from executive session. All members voted in favor.

19. Mrs. Manning made the motion to adjourn and Mr. Morris gave the second.
