

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE  
LEVY OF A FIVE MILL COUNTY SCHOOL  
TAX IN ST. CLAIR COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that the St. Clair County Commission has called and ordered a special election to be held in the County on January 30, 2018, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of the County, for their determination by ballot, the question of whether a special county tax of fifty cents on each one hundred dollars (equal to five mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of taxable property located within the County shall be levied for educational purposes for a period of thirty (30) consecutive years commencing with the tax year that began on October 1, 2017 (for which first tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2018), which levy shall be in addition to all other taxes now levied in the County for public school purposes.

The said election will be held at the voting places regularly established for County elections in the County between the legal hours for the holding of elections.
