**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR  
THE LEVY OF A THREE  
MILL DISTRICT SCHOOL TAX IN  
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1 IN ST. CLAIR COUNTY**

Notice is hereby given that the St. Clair County Commission has called and ordered a special election to be held in School District No. 1 on January 30, 2018, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said district, for their determination by ballot, the question of whether a special district tax of thirty cents on each one hundred dollars (equal to three mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of the taxable property located within the said school district shall be levied for public school purposes for a period of thirty (30) consecutive years commencing with the tax year that began on October 1, 2017 (for which first tax year the tax will become due and payable on October 1, 2018), which levy shall be in addition to all taxes now or hereafter levied in the district.

The boundaries of School District No. 1 are coterminous with those of St. Clair County and include all the territory lying therein LESS AND EXCEPT the territory lying within the corporate limits of the Cities of Leeds, Pell City and Trussville.

The said election will be held at the voting places regularly established for County elections in School District No. 1 between the legal hours for the holding of elections.
