

Sr. Mary Gabriel of the Trinity, OCD



May 28, 1926 - July 12, 2018

Eternal Rest grant unto her, O Lord,
and let Perpetual Light shine upon her.

May she rest in peace.

Sister Gabriel was born in San Francisco on May 28, 1926, and was baptized in the old Mission Dolores on June 22, 1926. She lived there in the Bay area until she entered Carmel on December 7, 1946, as a "mail order" Carmelite on Pearl Harbor Day!

Sister Gabriel filled many offices in Carmel: Prioress, Sacristan, Novice Mistress, Laundress, Turn Sister, Secretary, etc. She also took care of the Carmel's dogs, even in her later years.

In Sister Gabriel's 71 years in Carmel, she was always known to be faithful in coming to community acts, especially being on time for the Liturgy of the Hours! She loved to play "Mahjong" at recreation and would win almost every game, even up to the last month of her life. Parkinson's disease crippled Sister since 2013 and limited her activities, but never her love of reading.

Sister had been failing these last couple of months, and after a hospital stay of a few days she came home with hospice. All of her Sisters in Carmel were surrounding her with their prayers and singing of songs when she peacefully breathed her last. The special Feast of Sts. Zelig and Louis Martin (July 12) was chosen by God as her birthday into Heaven!

* * * * *

ABOUT THE CARMELITE NUNS IN ALHAMBRA: The Carmel of St. Teresa in Alhambra was established in 1913. Five Nuns from the monastery in St. Louis, Missouri, came to Los Angeles to begin the Carmelite life in Southern California. The Sisters lived in rented houses in Los Angeles for ten years until the present monastery was built in Alhambra. The area, which originally had been nothing but orange groves, was just beginning to be developed.

In 1924, when the Discalced Carmelite Friars established St. Therese Parish, the Discalced Carmelite Cloistered Nuns graciously opened their chapel to the Friars as a temporary Parish church. The Nuns of the Cloister never murmured at the inconvenience of sharing their chapel, but only assured the Friars that they were praying fervently that soon it would be possible to build the needed church (the first St. Therese Church was eventually built and consecrated in November 1926).

The lifestyle of the Cloistered Carmelite Nuns is almost as it was for St. Teresa of Avila (Prayer, Silence, Penance, and Sacrifice). A typical day begins at 5:30 a.m. and ends at 10:00 p.m. It is filled with various forms of prayer: Mass, personal prayer, spiritual reading, and the Divine Office. Manual labor, an external expression of the life of prayer and an expression of poverty, occupies half of their day. Please pray that Sr. Gabriel is in Heaven seeing God face to face!

Praise God for the Gift of Sr. Gabriel!




Sunday Breakfast on August 5th!





PEER MENTOR PROGRAM

We are working to improve our current family confirmation program. In today's society, it is of the utmost importance that our parents remain the first and foremost teachers of their children. It is vital that parents work to connect on a deeper level with their teens, and for teens to feel free to share their thoughts and experiences with their parents.

Our goal for the confirmation program is to have recently confirmed students return for a peer-mentoring program in order to give back to their younger peers. They would do this by sharing personal testimony about their experiences in having to defend their faith to those who are engaging in immoral or questionable anti-Christian behavior. For example, why do we as solid Catholics teach chastity? Why are we pro-life? How do we combat the contraceptive mentality? In today's society, these are the types of things our young people are facing every day of their lives at school, through social media, television and music, and at teen social events.

Our program goes beyond simply teaching about the Sacrament of Confirmation; the new mentoring program will enable the former confirmation students to guide the current students to becoming more open to sharing their faith as well as giving them the tools and confidence to make solid faith decisions throughout their high school and college years.

To be able to make this mentoring program a reality, we are seeking young people who live their lives as strong committed Catholics able to withstand the pressures of today's society.
