

Please Note: The 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, December 23, and the morning Masses and 1:00 p.m. Latin Mass on Sunday, December 24, are for the Fourth Sunday of Advent. The evening Masses on Sunday, December 24 (5:00 p.m., 7i:30 p.m., and the Midnight Mass) fulfill the obligation to attend Mass on Christmas Day. In other words, to fulfill your obligation, you must attend one Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and one Mass for Christmas (on either Christmas Eve or Christmas Day). The same condition applies for the Feast of the Holy Family and the Feast of the Solemnity of Mary.







If you placed an order for tamales the past two Sundays, your orders are ready for pick up after the morning Masses

PARENTS & GODPARENTS are required to attend a class from 7:30 to 9:00 p.m., in the Parish Library (next will be January 4 and January 25). The fee is \$100 per child OR \$25 for the class only. Baptisms are on Saturdays (next open are at 11:00 a.m., January 27 and February 10).

SELECTING THE GODPARENTS: Canon Law requires you to have at least one godparent (may have two) who: 1) is at least 16; 2) has been Confirmed; and 3) is a practicing Catholic. A form attesting to this needs to be signed by a priest from the parish of each prospective godparent.


