A teacher, parent, grandparent, or administrator can refer a student for gifted.

Screening Process

What kind of testing is performed?

After the referral papers are completed by the child's homeroom teacher, a test called the Raven is administered by the gifted class teacher at your child's school.

Once the student scores a certain percentage then other screening tests are performed by the District's Psychometrist.
