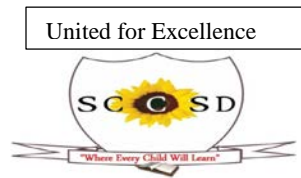

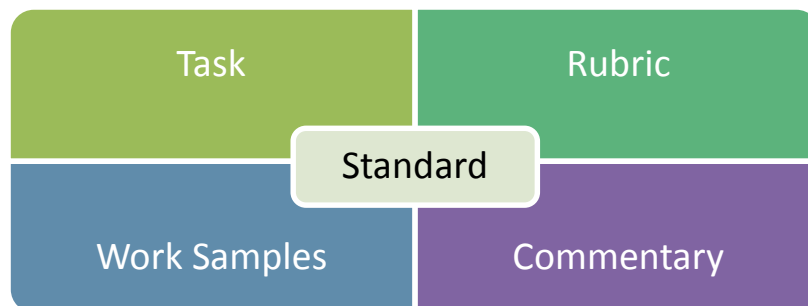
## District Expectations for Standards-Based Bulletin Board

### Overview of a Standard Based Bulletin Board

- Shows the connections between a student's work, the standard the work should meet, and assessment that is used to decide when the work meets the standard.
- **Standard Based Bulletin Board** can serve as an instructional tool for students, informational tool for parents and visitors, as well as an assessment tool for teachers and administrators on student tasks and activities.

**Standards-based Bulletin Board contains the following features:**

### Title



### Title

Each board has a title that describes the big picture. Teachers sometimes use catchy phrases or a play on words to entice someone walking by the board to stop and read.

### Standard

The standard is reproduced exactly like it is written in the curriculum framework.

### Task

The task is an explanation of what the class or student was asked to do.

### **Quality pieces of student work**

Quality pieces of student work should be posted that often show a range of work.

### **Rubrics/Criteria for Grading**

Rubrics/criteria for grading tell the students exactly what the expectations are for the assignment.

### **Commentary**

Each piece of student work includes a commentary written by the teacher that explains why the particular piece meets the standard or does not.
