The Individualized Education Program (IEP) Committee met to determine the appropriate placement of your child, ... Following a review of the requirements regarding placement options and considering your input as well as the education services necessary to ensure an appropriate education for your child, the team determined that a change in the current placement of your child is warranted.

The committee's decision was based on the following reason(s):
