What K through 5th grade parents can do to help their student be successful?

- 1. Attend school every day.**
- 2. Encourage reading, read aloud to your child, and read at least 20 minutes every day.**
- 3. Practice math facts.**
 - K – Recognizing numbers and counting to 100**
 - 1st – Addition Facts**
 - 2nd – Subtraction Facts**
 - 3rd – Multiplication Facts**
 - 4th - Division Facts**
 - 5th – All Math Facts**

What 6th through 8th grade parents can do?

- 1. Send your student to school every day.**
- 2. Review your student's planner nightly.**
- 3. Make sure you know your student's FOCUS information and check it at least once a week.**
- 4. Ask your student how their day went and what they learned. Be involved in their education.**

What 9th through 12th grade parents can do?

- 1. Attend all requested meetings when invited by the school.**
