These lessons and videos have been created by Paul Peavy, Taylor County Mental Health Coordinator, using resources from the National Institute of Mental Health. Mr. Peavy has been a Florida Licensed Mental Health Therapist for over twenty years serving children, adolescents and families in North Florida. He has worked with agencies such as The Department of Children and Family Services, Children’s Medical Services, and Florida State University.

These lessons, under the supervision of Mr. Peavy, will be implemented in the Language Arts classes for middle school students and homeroom for high school students. The video lesson entitled “Prevention of the Abuse and Addiction to Alcohol, Nicotine, and Drugs” will include a teacher handout with individual questions and classroom discussion or activities.
