What are the benefits of my children attending a Title 1 School?

Title 1 Funds are used by Taylor County Elementary School to provide:

- Teachers and Paraprofessionals
- Classroom materials and curriculum
- Parent Center with check out materials
- Parent workshops and materials
- SES Tutoring
- Staff development
- Enhanced technology

Title 1 Funds are used by the District to provide:

- After school tutoring (SES)
- Transportation for SES
- Reading Coach
- Math/Science Coach
- Parent Resource Center
- Staff Development

Title 1 Funds

- Allocated on basis of number of students eligible for free/reduced lunch. Schools receive Title 1 funds if 40% or more of students are eligible for free/reduced lunch.
-Schools are ranked according to this percentage, and schools receive a certain amount of money per student.

School Improvement Goals

- Increase the number of students scoring Proficient on STAR/IReady assessments.
- Increase students scoring on grade level or above on reading, writing, math, and science state assessment.
- Increase the opportunities for students to be involved in science inquiry in the classroom.
- Increase school wide attendance by keeping the average daily attendance at or above 95%.
- Increase parent involvement by implementing Parent Engagement Nights.
