Professional Development Providers – reminders and audits

Districts as PD Providers Guidance – **We will be glad to come to your district** to discuss renewal requirements with your staff – just let us know

1. Can I issue activity hours for it? Use this as a guide and for each activity.
2. What evidence does the recipient need to count if audited?
 - They need either... Evidence of Completion form 77-21B - OR -
 - Transcript from IL college or university with an ISBE approved teacher prep program
 - ♣ District can issue 77-21B for coursework from another college/university
3. Districts are providers so they can issue 77-21B for things folks do outside of the district if you warrant that it is good PD.
4. What a district should do for each activity they provide
 - ISBE Evaluation 77-21A from each recipient – paper or use Durley electronic version (Google Form)
 - Summary of responses for each item on 77-21A
 - Sign-in sheet for groups
 - Regular, ongoing related PD events (groups) should keep date and activity log
 - You can lump regular, ongoing related PD events together and issue one 77-21B o ISBE Year-End Approved Provider Report (June)
