- Make sure you have entered all required PD and completed required Admin Academies (and that they show on your PD screen)
- You should <u>select ROE 53</u> when you select an ROE to register. If you don't, you will have to go in later to do it. You must be registered in the region you will be part of in order to work there.
- \$10/year x 5 year cycle = \$50 + \$1.75 handling charge
- Next cycle remains same for admin 100 hours + Admin Academy each year
- ALL ROE 43 and 38 licensees will need to register with ROE 53 (PEL, Sub, Para)


