- ▶ Reference Guide Link on each page – shows examples of required evidence and/or method of verification
 - ▶ District cannot flag or lock an item – only the ROE can do this
 - ▶ If an item is locked by the ROE, no further edits can occur
 - ▶ **Schoolhouse icon** means it is an item that will be verified on site
 - ▶ If you do not include an evidence document or link, we will have to pester and gather it from you
