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ELIS Renewal Window

- Overall Renewal Window: April 1 to June 30th
- All PD entered by August 31st
- September 1 enter lapsed status

PEL and ELS-CTE licenses may renew beginning **April 1, 2018.**

ELS-PARA licenses may renew beginning **April 15, 2018.**

SUB licenses may renew beginning **May 1, 2018.**



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Substitute Teacher Application Reimbursement:

1. Your Sub issuance date must be later than July 1, 2017
2. You must work at least 10 full school days within one year of your issuance date
 - a. An educator may submit multiple forms to provide evidence of the total 10 days if experience was earned at multiple districts.
3. You must apply for the reimbursement within 18 months of your issuance date
4. Educator must complete form 73-02 “Substitute License Fee Refund Request” and have a district complete Part II: <https://www.isbe.net/Documents/73-02-Substitute-License-Fee-Refund-Request.pdf>.
5. The form must be emailed to sub10refund@isbe.net by the school district that completes Part II of the form. Forms emailed by the educator will not be accepted.
6. Refund comes ISBE not ROE

- Evidence of Completion form [77-21B](#) **OR**
- Transcript from IL college or university with an ISBE approved teacher prep program

** **The District can issue** 77-21B for and ISBE Evaluation [77-21A](#) coursework from another college/university

Districts are approved providers so they can issue 77-21B for things staffers do outside of the district if you warrant that it is good PD.



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Everyday PE Relief

SB1947 Now Public Act

A school board may determine the schedule or frequency of physical education courses, provided that a pupil engages in a course of physical education for a minimum of 3 days per 5-day week.

A physical education course of study shall provide students with an opportunity for an appropriate amount of daily physical activity. A physical education course of study must be part of the regular school curriculum and not extra-curricular in nature or organization.

A school board may also excuse pupils in grades 9 through 12 enrolled in a marching band program for credit from engaging in physical education courses if those pupils request to be excused for ongoing participation in such marching band program.

A school board may also, on a case-by-case basis, excuse pupils in grades 7 through 12 who participate in an interscholastic or extracurricular athletic program from engaging in physical education courses.
