


Longitudinal Progress Monitoring

Section Scores are placed on a vertical scale.



The same concept holds true for the **Test**, **Cross-Test Scores** and **Total Score**.




Sending Scores

Four free reports are included with SAT® registration.

Score Choice™ enables students to:

- Choose which scores to send to colleges by test administration.
- Send only the scores they want to send to colleges*.

^{*}Students will need to comply with an institution's stated scoreuse practice.



Students can use their free reports up to 9 days after their test date.



Use Benchmarks To Enhance College Readiness

SAT® College and Career Readiness Benchmarks

- 75% likelihood of earning at least a C in a first-semester, creditbearing college course in a related subject
- Set at section level
- Overall college and career readiness is defined as achieving both of the section-level benchmarks on a given assessment.
- Grade-level benchmarks are based on expected student growth toward the SAT Benchmarks:

Benchmark Rationale

- Simple definition of success:
 - Achieve credit in select first-semester, credit-bearing courses and/or 'major' courses
 - Consistent with consortia and other definitions of College Readiness
 - Clear definition for policy-makers
- Helps students understand where to take action
- Helps educators identify students who need additional support to get on track for college readiness

Reporting: Color-Coded Score Ranges

Section Scores

- A student who meets the benchmark for her grade level is in the green range
- A student who does not meet the benchmark for the previous grade level is in the red range
- A student in between these two ranges is in the yellow range
