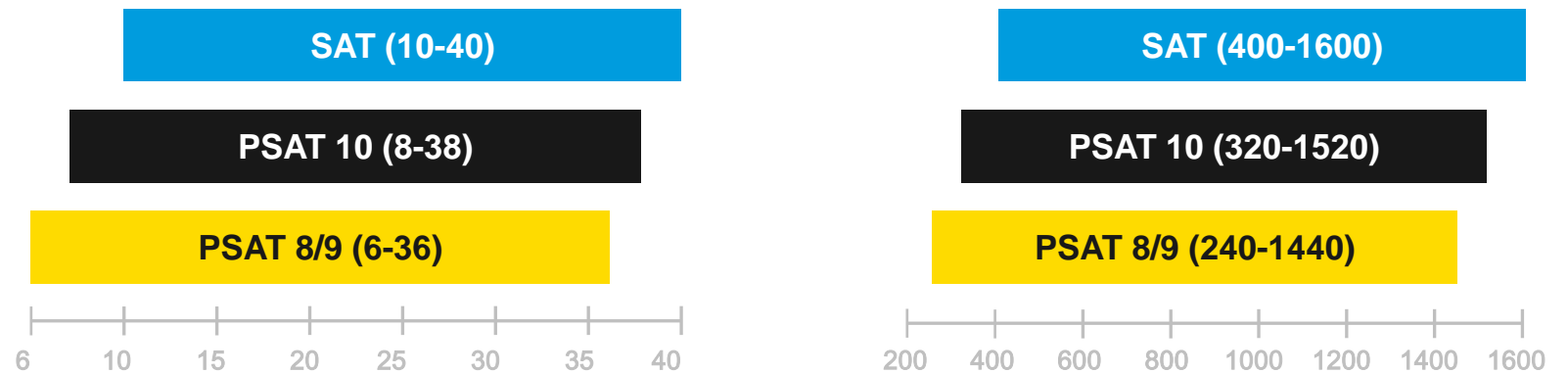


Longitudinal Progress Monitoring



- 75% likelihood of earning at least a C in a first-semester, credit-bearing college course in a related subject
- Set at section level
- Overall college and career readiness is defined as achieving both of the section-level benchmarks on a given assessment.
- Grade-level benchmarks are based on expected student growth toward the SAT Benchmarks:

Benchmark Rationale

- Simple definition of success:
 - Achieve credit in select first-semester, credit-bearing courses and/or 'major' courses
 - Consistent with consortia and other definitions of College Readiness
 - Clear definition for policy-makers
 - Helps students understand where to take action
 - Helps educators identify students who need additional support to get on track for college readiness

Reporting: Color-Coded Score Ranges

Section Scores

- A student who meets the benchmark for her grade level is in the **green** range
- A student who does not meet the benchmark for the previous grade level is in the **red** range
- A student in between these two ranges is in the **yellow** range
