Mrs. Whittington made a motion that student F be readmitted to Tazewell County Public Schools October 11, 2017. Mr. Jones seconded the motion, and the Committee unanimously approved.

Mrs. Whittington made a motion that student G be readmitted to the Placement Academy with random drug testing. Mr. Jones seconded the motion, and the Committee unanimously approved.
