1 The Board will be guided by the general mandatory powers and duties of the Board as defined through
2 statute¹ which state or imply that a local Board of Education has full power to operate the local public
3 schools as it deems fit in compliance with state and federal mandates. The Board functions only when
4 in session.

5 The board sees these as its required functions:

- 6 1. **Policy Oversight:**¹ The Board shall develop a policy manual and employ a chief school
7 administrator who shall carry out its policies through the development and implementation of
8 administrative procedures. The Board shall regularly evaluate the effectiveness of its policies
9 and their implementation.
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11 2. **Educational Planning:**² The Board shall require reliable information from responsible sources
12 which enable it and the staff to work toward the continuous improvement of the educational
13 program.

15 3. **Fiscal Planning:**³ The Board shall adopt a budget to provide the necessary funding in terms of
16 buildings, staff, materials and equipment to enable the school system to carry out its functions.
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- 18 4. **Promotion:** The Board shall keep the local community informed about the school system, its
19 accomplishments, and its actions. The Board shall build public support for the schools by
20 involving the public in the planning process.

21 The Board shall provide the best educational opportunities possible for all children.

22 The Board shall exercise its powers through the enactment of policies for the organization and
23 operation of the school system. The Board shall delegate the administration of the schools to the
24 director of schools.
