1 The Board will work for the passage of new laws designed to advance the cause of improving
2 education and for the repeal or modification of existing laws and the defeat of proposed laws that
3 impede this cause.

4 To accomplish this:

- 5 1. The Board shall stay informed of pending legislation and actively communicate its concerns
6 and make its position known to their elected representatives at both the state and national level;
- 7 2. The Board shall work with other school boards in the state, local citizen groups, and other local
8 officials in acquainting them with the board's legislative priorities and seek their support;
- 9 3. The Board shall annually select one (1) of its members to serve as its representative to the
10 Tennessee Legislative Network (TLN):
- 11 4. The Board shall work with its TLN representative, TSBA, NSBA, and other concerned groups
12 in developing an annual legislative program; and
- 13 5. The Board shall include in its budget appropriate resources, including travel expense,
14 neces-sary for its TLN representative and other board members to accomplish its desired
15 legislative goals.
